

# AskSara – Sefton’s online tool to make independent living easier and smarter



Sefton Council has launched an online service called AskSARA.

What does it do?

- It asks questions about your daily life.
- It uses the answers you give to see what support you may need.
- AskSARA then shows information and a range of products and services to suit your needs and help you to live independently for longer.



AskSARA is easy to use. It asks you to choose from a wide range of topics, then answer some questions and view your personalised report.



Ask SARA will

- Help people to find information about aids, adaptations, and technology.
- Give a personal report that links to a catalogue of local suppliers that can provide over 10,000 products.
- Help with decision making and buying your own aids and equipment. This can be paid for by yourself or through Direct Payments.
- Give information about personal budgets and how to apply for Direct Payment Grants.



Ask SARA is part of the improvements Sefton wants to make so more people can use digital support. There is a plan called the Technology Enabled Care Solutions Strategy 2021-24 that you can find on the Council's website.
